### Holiday club

### Change of dates/new dates

### Leave of absence in term time

**The attendance level that schools need to achieve has increased from 95% to 96%.**

Schools are being reminded that they have a duty to promote good attendance. **Absence in term time can only be granted in exceptional circumstances.**

Any leave of absence during term time needs to be requested. Request forms can be found in the school entrance and should be returned to Mrs Mills. It is at Miss Swards descretion if the leave is authorised/unauthorised and if a fine should be issued.

### Supervision on the playground

Can you please ensure that in a morning and at the end of the day your children are not running up and down the banking or the steps at the end of the playground. We have had a number of injuries caused by children falling down the steps or tumbling down the banking.

The adventure playground is out of use at the moment, the wooden structure is not safe, school is awaiting it's demolition and a new surface laid in its place. Could parents please keep there children off the structure at the start and end of the school day.

### Safe in the Sun

Please ensure that as the weather gets warmer your child has a water bottle in school (that can be refilled throughout the day), a sunhat and suntan lotion (at least spf 50) that they can apply themselves if necessary. Children also need to have suntan lotion applied before they come to school. The children are spending time on the field throughout the day, it's important they are protected from the sun and have the opportunity to have a drink when they need to.

### Car park gates

The gates are now closed from 8.45am in the morning and from 3pm in the afternoon, this is to prevent accidents occurring in the car park. People who have disabled badges may use the car park but will need to open the gates to enter the car park and shut the gates behind them when leaving the car park.

**Please do not park in front of the car park gates.**
