In 2015/2016, Arkwright Primary School will receive approximately £8100 pounds funding from the Department of Education.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including the increasing participation of pupils in PE and sport. The aim is that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

How will we be spending the PE and sport funding?

- School will continue to affiliate to the Bolsover and District School Sport Partnership. In affiliating to the partnership the school will continue to access the following:

 - Curriculum support
 - Signposting to local clubs
 - Bikeability programme
 - Balanceability programme
 - Change 4 life programme
 - Sharing of good practice through regular PLT/Headteacher meetings at cluster and sports partnership level.
 - Mini leader programme
 - Sports reporter programme
